BASIC DSLR CAMERA OPERATION

This is a basic DSLR camera class in which you will learn about all of the different settings on your camera. The class will concentrate on the manual settings rather than relying on automatic settings. My goal is to have you capturing the moments as you imagine them, without disappointment.

This class is a basic overview of Photoshop and will only cover a small amount of its capabilities. INTRO TO THE iPad

This class a basic iPad class where you will learn about the functional operations of the device. BASIC MOTORCYCLE BEGINNER COURSE

The Basic Rider Course is designed to provide a foundation of knowledge and skills for people who have never ridden, as well as those who have ridden up to 10,000 miles. Motorcycles and helmets are provided. The BRC course can be taken in lieu of the range-riding portion of the Department of Revenue license examination. Those who successfully complete the course will be issued a completion card from the Motorcycle Safety Foundation, which is recognized by many insurance companies for premium discounts. **The course fee is \$200.**
